### By Law.

# RULES FOR THE APPROVAL OF HISTORIC VEHICLES REGISTERED BY THE RMS UNDER THE CONDITIONAL REGISTRATION SCHEME AND TRIAL LOG BOOK SCHEME KNOWN AS HVS AND THE MODIFIED VEHICLE SCHEME KNOWN AS THE CLASSIC VEHICLE SCHEME.(CVS) Part 1- Eligibility

- a) Vehicles registered under the HVS or CVS scheme must be a Triumph manufactured car.
- b) All modified Triumph manufactured cars will be accepted under the Classic Vehicle Scheme regardless of membership level.
- c) Non-Triumph cars will be approved for both schemes, provided that the owner is a full, family or life member.
- d) Non-Triumph cars owned by social members will only be considered for approval if the owner has been a member of the association for more than three years.
- e) Applications will only be considered from current financial members.
- f) The Committee reserves the right to refuse approval on reasonable grounds.
- g) Each vehicle must be declared roadworthy by a Safety Check Inspection at an Authorized Inspection Station.
- h) Note: It is the owner's responsibility to comply with all RMS requirements.

# Part 2 Responsibilities of owners

- I. All enquiries must be directed to the Concessional Registration officer. Individual approaches to the Services NSW are not permitted.
- II. Plates must be returned immediately to the Services NSW authority and the conditional registration cancelled.
- III. In the event of the sale of the vehicle
- IV. Upon the owner ceasing to be a member of the club
- V. Upon the member failing to remain a financial member within the meaning of the Constitution of the club or failure to pay any levy that may be constitutionally approved by a duly constituted club meeting.
- VI. At the directive of a Club Committee decision
- VII. If the club Committee considers the vehicle has been made unsafe or altered after it has been inspected
