These by laws are formulated under section 14 of the articles of association and take effect from 14th March 2023

By Law 4:

Rules for awarding points for Concours trophies in, d'elegance , d'Original and Competition classes.

Cars must be Triumph manufactured to be eligible

All Vehicles will be judged according to the d'Elegance score sheet, then additional points will be added from the competion or d'Original sheets

<u>Concours d'Elegance</u>:

Note I: Competition and Ecurie entrants are not scored down because they don't have carpet but may be scored down on presentation of floor

Note 2: Competition and Ecurie entrants are scored on presentation of safety equipment (roll bars/cages, fire extinguisher, etc) in this section.

Note 3: Competition and Ecurie entrants are to have "other accessories" such as camera brackets, shift lights, and data-loggers scored here.

Note: 4 Competition and Ecurie entrants are not required to display (nor be judged on) spares or tools but if displayed they should be judged.

Note: 5 Concours d'Original judging requires a minimum score of 360
