

## TSOA (NSW) Inc By-Laws

These by laws are formulated under section 24 of the constitution and take effect from 10<sup>th</sup> March 2020.

### By Law 4:

#### Rules for awarding points for Concours trophies in, d'elegance , d'Original and Competition classes.

All Vehicles will be judged according to the d'Elegance score sheet, then additional points will be added from the competition or d'Original sheets

#### Concours d'Elegance:

Note 1: Competition and Ecurie entrants are not scored down because they don't have carpet but may be scored down on presentation of floor

Note 2: Competition and Ecurie entrants are scored on presentation of safety equipment (roll bars/cages, fire extinguisher, etc) in this section.

Note 3: Competition and Ecurie entrants are to have "other accessories" such as camera brackets, shift lights, and data-loggers scored here.

Note: 4 Competition and Ecurie entrants are not required to display (nor be judged on) spares or tools but if displayed they should be judged.

Note: 5 Concours d'Original judging requires a minimum score of **360**

### Competition Class Vehicles

Competition Class: To be eligible in the competition section the vehicle must have competed in a minimum of one race meeting (as recorded in the vehicle log book or verified by the competition secretary) in the twelve months since the last concour.

Cars are to be presented as they would be for scrutineering.

10 points will be awarded for every verified race meeting, (maximum 40 points can be awarded)

Overall Appearance; Viewed at a distance of Ten meters, does the vehicle look like the Triumph model it is based on? (Maximum of 20 points to be awarded)
