

TSOA (NSW) Inc By-Laws

These by laws are formulated under section 24 of the constitution and take effect from 10th March 2020.

By Law5.

Competition Points Score

Purpose: To promote club level Motorsport, camaraderie between all participants (including spectators and other clubs) and to award the fastest drivers in each class.

Event(s): All Combined Sports Car Association (CSCA) rounds and the Motorsport competition events held during the TSOA National Meeting.

Eligibility: Compete in at least three (3) nominated competition events in that class.

Scoring: **Classes** are “open”, meaning that modifications are allowed so long as the vehicle retains its marque car status as defined by the Club. **Points** are awarded by TSOA marque class (not the competition class they may have run under): First in class: 9 pts, second in class: 6 pts, third: 4 pts, fourth: 3 pts fifth: 2 pts with all other starter awarded 1 point.

NON-MARQUE (Non-Triumph cars and Triumphs no longer recognised as marque cars)

OUTRIGHT (Open to all drivers of Triumph Marque Cars)

FEMALE (Open to all female drivers of Triumph Marque Cars)

JUNIOR (Open to drivers of Triumph Marque cars who have not/will not attain the age of 21 by December 31 of the competition year)
